The Board finds itself without any buildings for the Experiment Station, without any farm for experimental work, and with no money, outside of the restricted appropriation for building purposes, with which to provide either. The Director found the Station without a staff of scientific workers and with no place to put them if he had them. It will thus be seen that we are starting with the foundation. It need not be expected that the Station can accomplish much scientific work until we have had time to overcome the difficulties facing us. It is hoped that the farmers of West Virginia will press the matter of agricultural education in our State so vigorously in the near future that our...
