In 1890, however, its occurrence in Sumatra was recorded by Max Weber (*Zool. Ergebn.*, p. 176). The Malay Peninsula may now be added to its habitat. A few months ago the British Museum received from Mr. L. Wray, Curator of the Perak Government Museum, a fine half-grown specimen, with the following remarks: - The specimen was caught at Pulau Tiga, in the Perak river, in June, 1895, and I kept it in a pond until the end of December, when it was killed. For months it would eat nothing but a few small fish, but during the latter portion of the time it would eat...
